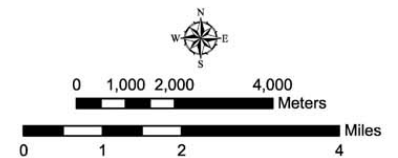


May 6, Relative Shorebird Use of the South Bay Salt Ponds

This map shows the relative use of different South Bay salt ponds by shorebird "salt pond specialists" as indicated by the proportion of shorebirds counted in different survey areas.
